- Operates in universities, corporate hubs, metro routes, and residential clusters
- Ideal for short-distance rides (1–5 km)
- Quick pick-up, easy navigation in high-traffic areas
- Ensures safe rides for women and young girls
- Provides flexible earning opportunities for women who prefer two-wheeler driving

Bike Didis increase women's mobility, reduce dependency on unsafe modes of travel, and provide confidence and convenience for daily commuters.

AUTO DIDI

Auto Didi symbolizes women professionally driving E-Auto L5 vehicles, offering safe, clean, and affordable transport options across Delhi.

Key Highlights:

- Trained in defensive driving, customer service, and safety protocols
- Operates at metro stations, market hubs, hospitals, and high-footfall corridors
- Equipped with GPS, panic buttons, and safety sensors
- Suitable for medium-distance urban routes (3–12 km)

Impact:

Auto Didis break traditional gender barriers in the three-wheeler segment and become visible examples of Nari Shakti on the roads, inspiring other women to join mobility entrepreneurship.

TAXI DIDI

Taxi Didi refers to women trained to operate E-Cars and four-wheeler taxi services, offering premium, safe, and comfortable rides for women, children, and families.

- Specialized in long-distance and full-day assignments
- Equipped with advanced vehicle safety systems
- Highest livelihood potential among the three segments

Safety Features



Technical Modifications for Enhanced Security in Mahila Saarthi Vehicles:

To ensure the safety and security of women passengers and drivers, the following technical modifications will be incorporated into the vehicles used in the Mahila Saarthi project:

1. GPS Tracking System

- **Real-time tracking for live location updates.**
- **Integrated with a centralized monitoring system for immediate response in case of emergencies.**

2. Panic Button (SOS System)

- **Strategically placed buttons in both the passenger and driver areas.**
- **Alerts a 24/7 control room and shares live location with emergency responders when activated.**

3. Surveillance Cameras

- **High-definition cameras installed inside the vehicle for real-time monitoring.**
- **Footage stored in a secure cloud-based system to ensure privacy and provide evidence in case of incidents.**

4. Audio Alert System

- **Automated voice announcements for safety tips and emergency instructions.**
- **Alerts triggered for sudden stops or unauthorized route deviations.**

Safety Features



- **Smart Door Locking System**
 - Remote-controlled locks that can be overridden from the control room in emergencies.
 - Doors automatically lock when the vehicle is in motion and unlock upon halting safely.
- **Two-Way Communication System**
 - Integrated intercom system connecting the driver to the central control room for immediate assistance.
 - Enabled through a mobile app for seamless communication.
- **Geo-Fencing**
 - Vehicles restricted to operate within predefined safe zones.
 - Alerts generated for unauthorized travel beyond the designated boundaries.
- **Speed Governors**
 - Limits vehicle speed to ensure adherence to safety norms.
 - Prevents overspeeding, reducing accident risks.
- **Mobile App Integration**
 - Passenger app includes an SOS button for additional safety.
 - Real-time trip sharing option for passengers with family or friends.

Benefits of Mahila Saarthi for Ride Partner



- **Safety and Well-being:** Each driver receives a helmet, health kit, and first aid kit box, ensuring their safety and well-being on the road
- **Stable Income:** Mahila Saarthi provides women with a stable income, enabling them to support themselves and their families financially.
- **Flexible Work Hours:** Ride partners enjoy flexible work hours, allowing them to balance work and personal responsibilities effectively.
- **Safe Working Environment:** The platform ensures a safe working environment by allowing female partners to exclusively serve female passengers, eliminating discomfort associated with male passengers.
- **Empowerment and Training:** Through comprehensive training and support programs, Mahila Saarthi fosters assertiveness in traditionally male-dominated spaces, empowering female ride partners.

Before Mahila Saarthi in Terms of Women Safety



- **Limited Mobility:**

- Women often avoided traveling alone, especially during late hours, due to fear of harassment and violence in public spaces.
- Access to essential services and employment opportunities was restricted, particularly in remote and underserved areas.

- **Lack of Safe Transportation:**

- Public transportation options were often unreliable and unsafe, with incidents of harassment and assault being common.
- Women had limited access to female-only transportation services, leaving them vulnerable to unsafe situations.

- **High Crime Rates:**

- Incidents of violence against women in public spaces were prevalent, contributing to a general sense of insecurity and fear.
- Law enforcement struggled to provide timely intervention, with limited resources to monitor and respond to incidents in real-time.

- **Economic Disempowerment:**

- Women's participation in the workforce was limited due to concerns about safety during their commute.
- Lack of economic opportunities in the transportation sector for women drivers, leading to gender disparities in employment.

After Mahila Saarthi in Terms of Women Safety



- **Enhanced Mobility:**
 - Women now have access to a dedicated transportation service that prioritizes their safety, allowing them to travel confidently at any time.
 - Increased mobility has led to greater access to essential services, employment, and educational opportunities, especially in rural and remote areas.
- **Safe and Reliable Transportation:**
 - The introduction of women-driven ride-sharing services has significantly reduced the risk of harassment and violence in public transportation.
 - The availability of a mobile app with GPS tracking, emergency alerts, and secure payment options ensures a safe and convenient travel experience.
- **Reduction in Crime Rates:**
 - A noticeable decline in incidents of violence against women in public spaces, thanks to the proactive measures and real-time monitoring introduced by Mahila Saarthi.
 - Collaboration with law enforcement agencies has improved response times and the effectiveness of interventions, creating a safer environment for women.
- **Economic Empowerment:**
 - The project has created numerous employment opportunities for women as drivers, contributing to their economic independence and empowerment.
 - Women's increased participation in the transportation sector has challenged traditional gender roles and paved the way for greater gender equality in the workforce.

Basic Requirements for Becoming an Mahila Saarthi Partner

- Vehicle: Prospective Mahila Saarthi partner must possess their E-Scooty/E-Auto/EV Car initially.
- Driving License (DL): Valid driving license is mandatory.
- Knowledge of Local traffic rules and regulations.
- Fulfillment of KYC requirements for authentication.



Training Content



- **Traffic Rules:** Our training program covers essential driving skills, including vehicle operation, traffic rules, and safe driving practices.
- **Communication Skills:** Our training includes modules on communication techniques, customer interaction, and handling various scenarios to ensure that MS drivers can communicate confidently and professionally with passengers.
- **Self-Defense Training:** This training instills confidence and empowers our drivers to handle any potential risks effectively.
- **Self-Defense Kit:** A compact self-defense kit designed for women's empowerment. Featuring pepper spray, personal alarm, and educational resources, it equips women with tools and confidence to stay safe in any situation.

Role of the WECD



Nodal Support Department for Women Safety & Empowerment under Mahila Saarthi

1. Identification & Mobilization of Women Beneficiaries

- Support district-level mobilization through Anganwadi networks, SHGs, and community workers.
- Prioritize vulnerable, unemployed, and eligible women for onboarding.

2. Facilitation Under Nirbhaya Fund Framework

- Align the Mahila Saarthi initiative with women safety schemes.
- Support approvals, fund eligibility, and compliance under WECD guidelines.

3. Convergence with Women Safety Ecosystem

- Coordinate with Delhi Police, Transport, Tourism, and Urban Local Bodies.
- Enable safe pickup points, lighting, CCTV coverage, and women-centric zones.

5. Monitoring & Impact Evaluation

- Review progress reports submitted by CBEIC.
- Conduct joint field visits and assessments of women drivers' well-being and income progression.

6. Awareness & Sensitization Initiatives

- Promote gender sensitization among commuters and civic stakeholders.
- Support media outreach and state-level campaigns on women-led mobility.

7. Policy Facilitation & Institutional Support

- Recommend policies for women driver licensing, insurance, and safety.
- Advocate for scaling the model across districts and state programs.

Role of Transport Department



Regulatory Oversight and Compliance:

- **Licensing and Registration:** The Transport Department is responsible for ensuring that all vehicles used in the Mahila Saarthi project are properly licensed and registered according to government regulations. This includes verifying the compliance of e-scooters, e-autos, and other vehicles with safety and environmental standards.
- **Driver Certification:** The department oversees the certification process for women drivers participating in the project, ensuring they meet the required legal and safety standards. This includes background checks, driver's license verification, and ongoing compliance with driving regulations.

2. Vehicle Procurement and Allocation:

- **Fleet Approval:** The Transport Department collaborates with project partners to approve the types of vehicles used in the project, focusing on safety, efficiency, and sustainability. This includes selecting and approving electric vehicles (e-scooters and e-autos) that align with the project's environmental and operational goals.
- **Vehicle Allocation:** The department plays a role in the equitable allocation of vehicles across different regions, ensuring that all areas, especially those with high demand for women-centric transportation, are adequately served.

3. Infrastructure Development Support:

- **Safe Pickup and Drop-off Points:** The Transport Department is involved in identifying and developing safe pickup and drop-off points for Mahila Saarthi vehicles. These locations are strategically chosen to ensure the safety and convenience of women passengers.
- **Charging Infrastructure:** The department facilitates the development of necessary infrastructure, such as charging stations for electric vehicles, in collaboration with local authorities and private partners, ensuring the smooth operation of the project's fleet.

4. Policy Support and Advocacy:

- **Policy Formulation:** The Transport Department plays a crucial role in formulating and advocating for policies that support the Mahila Saarthi project. This includes policies related to women's safety in transportation, subsidies for electric vehicles, and incentives for women drivers.

Role of Transport Department

Training and Onboarding: They are responsible for ensuring that recruited drivers receive the necessary training and onboarding to familiarize them with the program's objectives, policies, and procedures. This includes organizing training sessions, providing informational materials, and facilitating orientation programs for new drivers.

Fleet Management: The location partner oversees the management and maintenance of the fleet of vehicles assigned to their area. This includes coordinating vehicle inspections, scheduling maintenance activities, and ensuring that all vehicles are in optimal condition for operation.



Customer Service: They are tasked with addressing any customer inquiries, complaints, or issues related to Mahila Saarthi services within their area. This involves providing timely and effective assistance to passengers, resolving disputes, and maintaining high levels of customer satisfaction.
